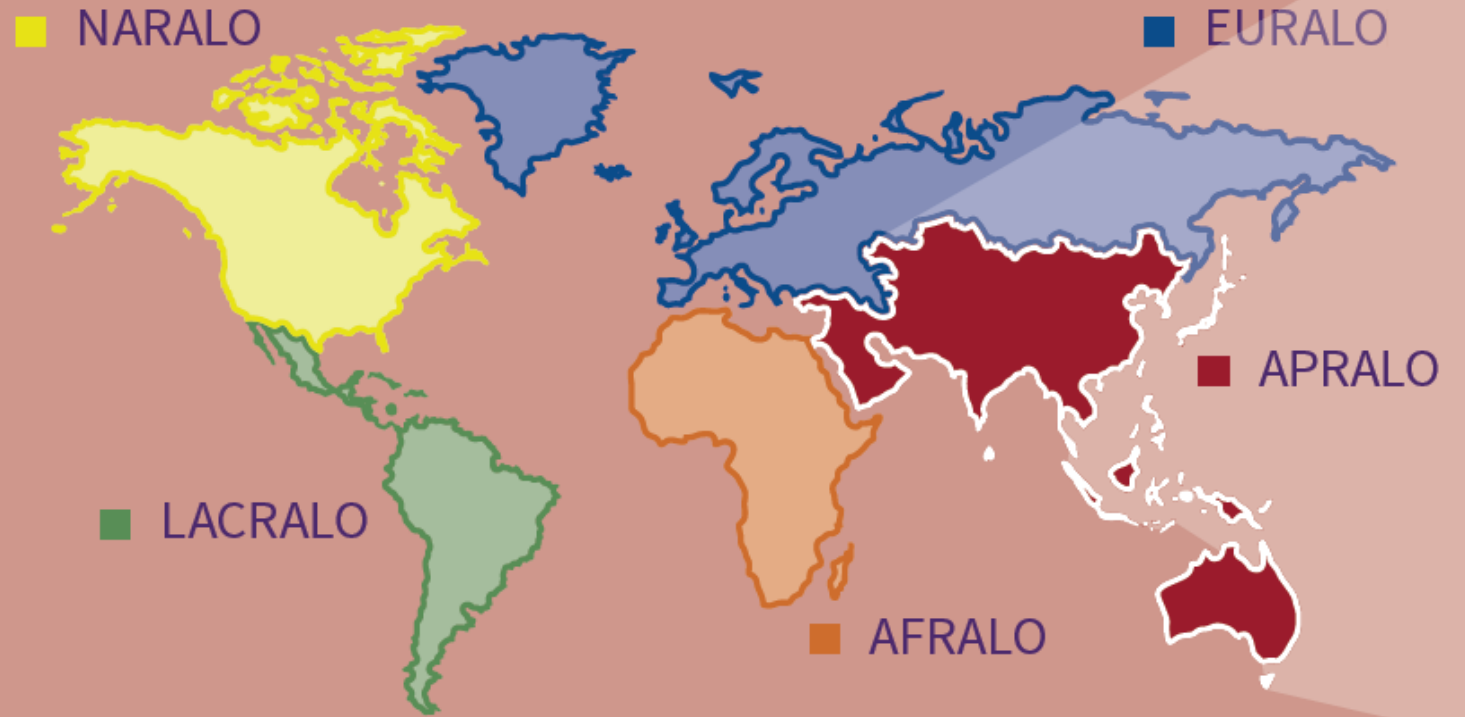

AT-LARGE REVIEW: EMM

CURRENT

- **At-Large Structures (ALS)**
 - Groups of locally based individual end-users (some countries have more than one group)
 - Formal registration and due diligence application process about ALS purpose, etc. ALAC-approved.
 - Leaders are the primary contacts and usually are the primary participants
 - Primary contacts are generally the key distributors of information back to base (ALS members and community)
 - All ALS members have a right to participate
 - Currently ALSes are the only voting members in APRALO
 - APRALO LT currently looking at a review of individual membership registration criteria

ITEMS

- **Empowered Membership Model (EMM)**
 - Focus is on individual membership - empowering individuals - giving them a voice
 - Membership can be through meeting basic criteria – name, AP address and non-affiliation with an ALS
 - No information required of ICANN interest or skill sets -
 - No requirement for disseminating what individuals learn and know beyond their own interests
 - Have to be “active” for 3 months to become a RALO/ALAC leader
 - Have to be a “rapporteur/liaison” for a year to earn attendance at 3 ICANN meetings

AT-LARGE REVIEW: EMM

CURRENT

- **At-Large Advisory Committee (ALAC)**
 - 15 members representing 5 regions
 - 2/3 members elected by the RALO ALSes
 - (RALO leadership is separate)
 - 1 member nominated by the NOMCOM
 - Normally maximum of 2 terms (4 years)
 - An ALAC (or non-ALAC) member is appointed by mutual agreement with the SO/AC to act as their liaison
 - Represent the needs and interests of global consumers

ITEMS

- **ALAC - Empowered Membership Model (EMM)**
 - 15 members
 - 2 from each region are RALO Leaders – they are expected to do both roles
 - 5 members are appointed by the NOMCOM to take up the liaison role with the ccNSO, GNSO, GAC, SSAC and Dot Mobi
 - At-Large working groups are scrapped (includes internal capacity building and development WGs - Outreach and Engagement, Capacity Building, Metrics, New gTLDs, etc)
