- Agenda determined based on consultation



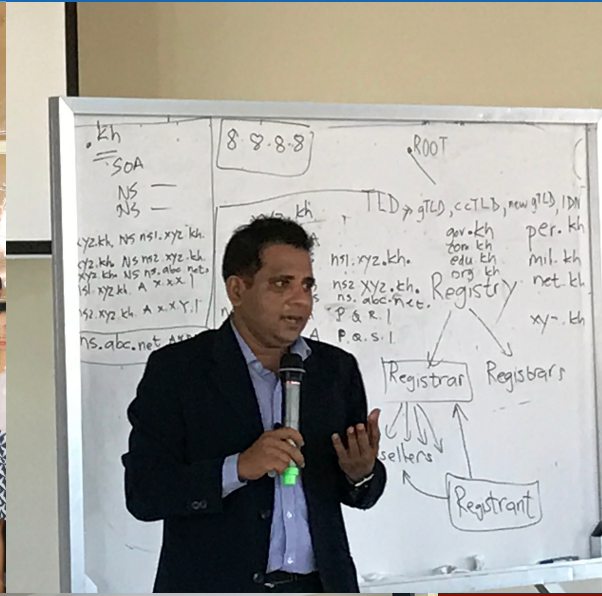

Key Signing Key (KSK) Rollover

- ⦿ Update your system with the public part of the new KSK (the root “trust anchor”)
 - Available from <https://www.iana.org/dnssec/files>
- ⦿ Key dates of the process when end users may experience interruption in Internet services:
 - **19 September, 2017**
Size increase for DNSKEY response from root name servers
 - **11 October, 2017 – Most important date**
New KSK used for signing for the first time
 - **11 January, 2018**
The old KSK is revoked
