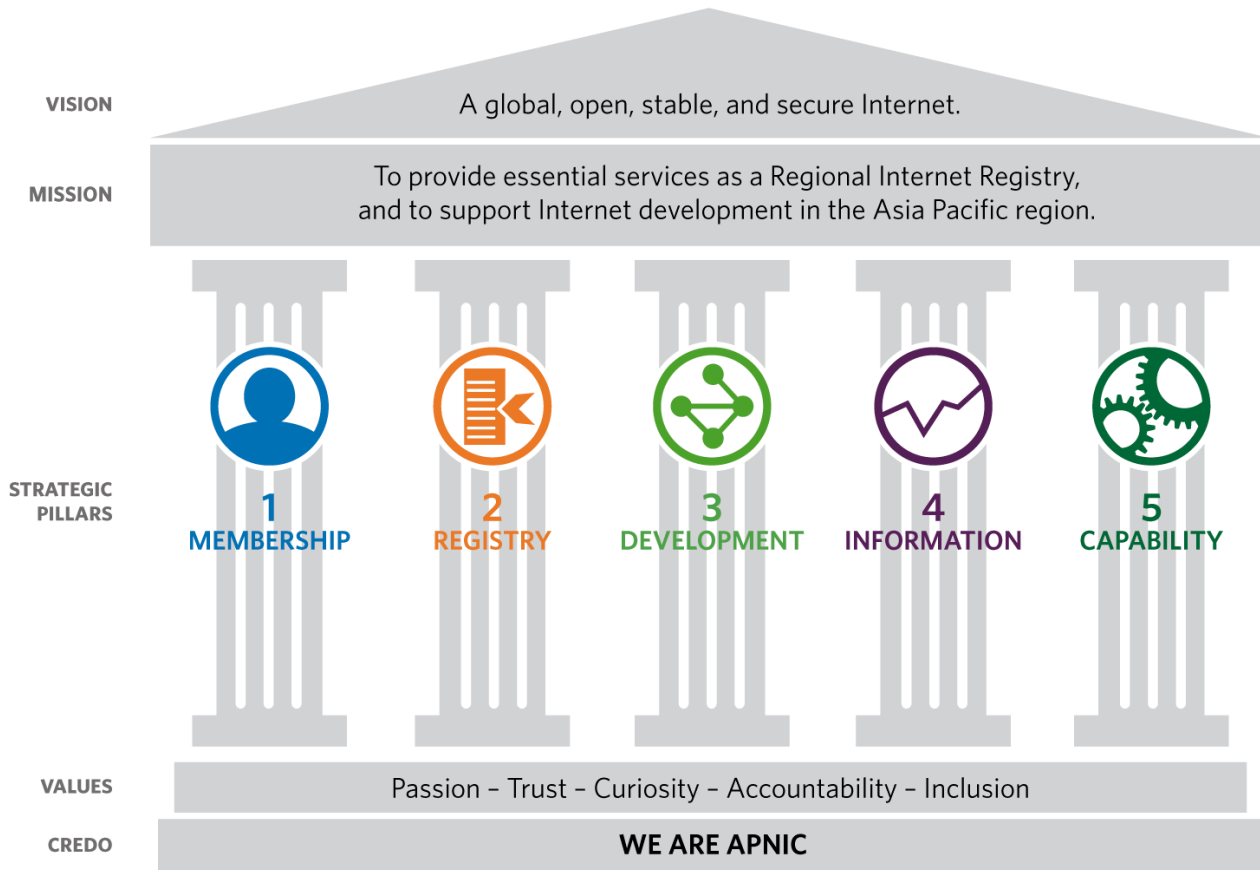

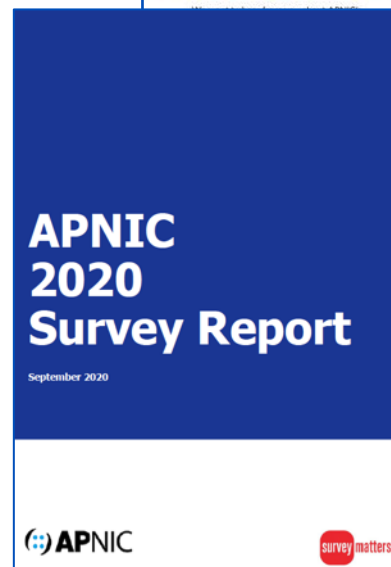
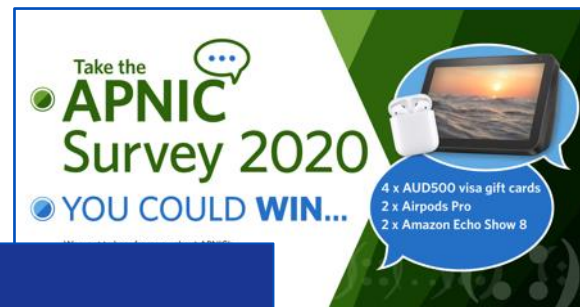

APNIC Survey 2020



- April: 41 remote interviews with stakeholders across 26 economies
- July: Online Survey conducted in 16 languages
 - 1,624 valid responses (↑ 31%)
 - 35% completed survey in language other than English

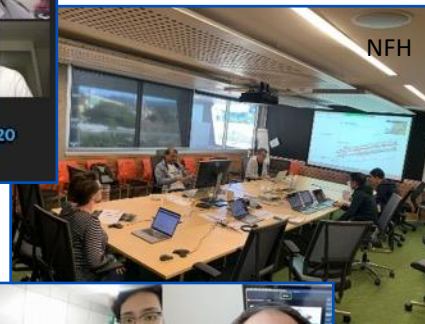
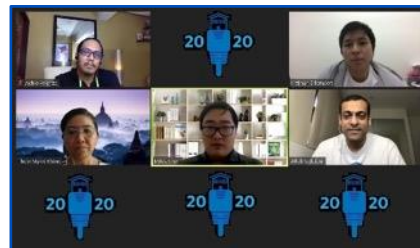

Networking From Home



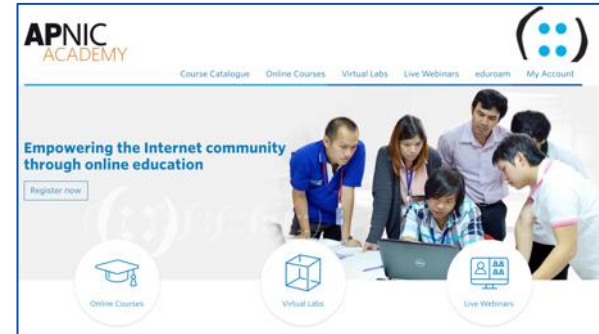
- Response to COVID-19 cancellations
- Sub-regional Schedule
 - South East Asia 2 Jun
 - South Asia 17 Jun
 - East Asia 15 Jul
 - Oceania 4 Aug
 - For local timezones
- Cooperation with 21 NOGs
 - Four PCs with NOG reps
- 1,219 participants from 45 economies
 - Avg session duration 1:40 hours (67% of each 2.5-hour event)
 - 91% participants from Asia Pacific



APNIC Academy



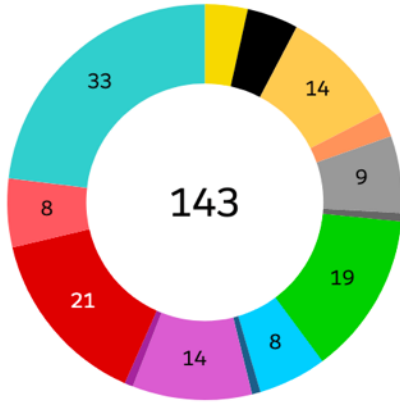
- New online Training Program under COVID-19

 - IXP support to Fiji IX, VNIX, Maldives IX, HKIX, MyIX (upgrades, route server filtering policy, designs)
 - Academy platform TA feature in development



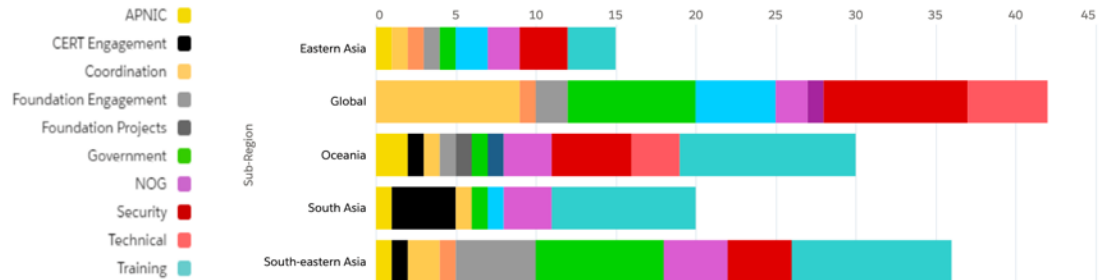
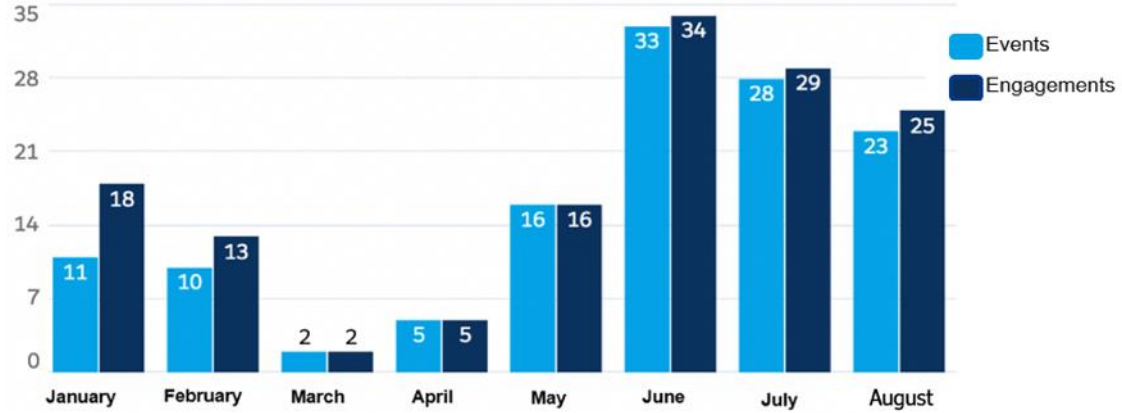
