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Advantages of Sustaining the APNG Camp

Key Challenges

1. Legal Status: APNG lacks formal legal recognition.
2. Funding Constraints: Securing sufficient financial support is challenging.
3. Volunteer Workload: Heavy reliance on volunteers puts pressure on committee members.

Strategies for Tackling Challenges

1. **Strengthen Structure:** Ensure APNG has a clear, sustainable organizational framework.
2. **Partner with Vision:** Align with local hosts that share APNG's mission.
3. **Secure Early Commitments:** Plan future camps with committed local partners in advance.
4. **Plan Sustainably:** Aim for quality over quantity, ensuring depth and impact.
5. **Focus on Quality:** Prioritize the depth and relevance of camp content.
