

IPv6 measurement End user readiness: World



IPv6 deployment leaderboard in the World (commercial operators)

- Many commercial operators with more than 30% of IPv6 ready end users ration
 - Verizon Wireless (AS22394, US): 68.96%
 - Telenet (AS6848, BE): 50.58%
 - Chubu Telecommunications (AS18126, JP): 36.33%
 - T-Mobile USA (AS21928, US): 30.68%
 - StarHab Internet (AS55430, SG): 26.63%
- IPv6 deployment is increasing steadily
 - But varies among regions, economies, and individual ASNs
 - Particularly some mobile network operators and cable TV operators with high level of IPv6 readiness
 - Once they enable IPv6 in their network and handsets, their end user readiness grows VERY rapidly
 - Not happening simultaneously across stakeholders
 - Need to provide continuous support to the industry
