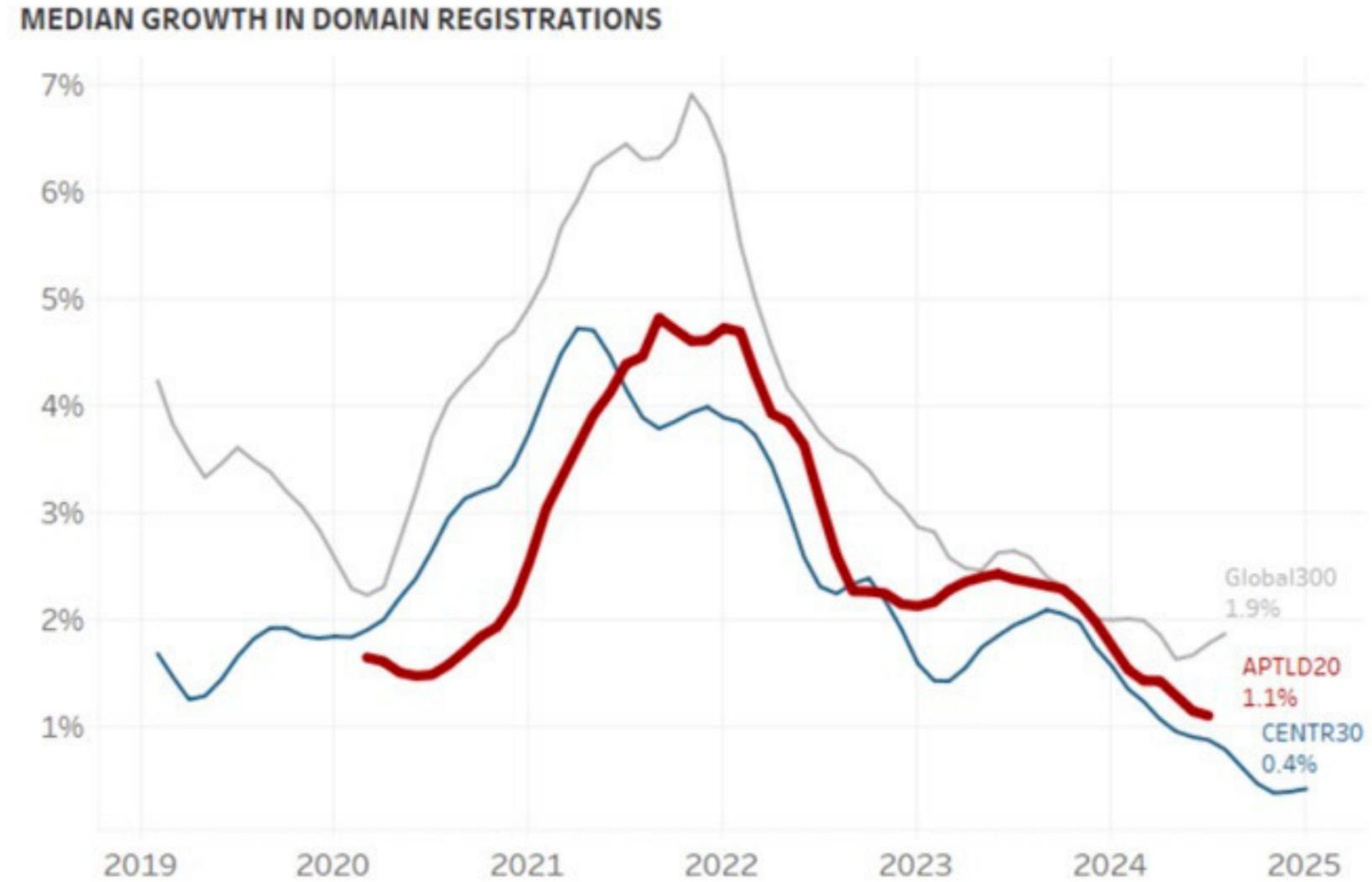




## **Some Statistic:**

- 1. APTLD Membership Distribution total 77 – 47 Ordinary Members and 30 Associate Members.**
- 2. Member Affiliation Breakdown – Government-affiliated (~ 50%), Others (NGO), and Universities (3).**
- 3. Linguistic & Governmental Distribution – English is an official/mother tongue (18) and those that are government-affiliated registries (18).**
- 4. Registry Size Distribution – >1M (7)**
- 5. APTLD Members in Top 10 ccTLDs**

**The Asia Pacific region has seen strong growth in top-level domains, outperforming Europe and trailing the global average.**

This chart shows the long term trend of domain growth. Values that make the line are the median 1 year growth rates of the TLDs in the sample. The 1 year growth is calculated per TLD, per month as the percentage difference between domains in the recent month compared to 12 months prior.

### **APTLD Growth**

The Asia Pacific Top-Level Domain Association (APTLD) reported a median growth rate of 1.1% in January 2025.

### **European Growth**

The Top 30 European ccTLDs reported a median growth rate of 0.4% as of January 2025.

### **Global Growth**

The Global 300 top-level domains saw a median growth rate of 1.9% as of January 2025.

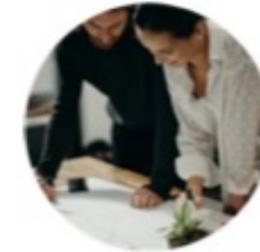
## Vision & Plan
